LEADERSHIP WORKSHOP**

After receiving numerous requests to extend the GLW application deadline due to extenuating circumstances, the deadline for applying to the two summer sessions has been extended. Applications postmarked by Monday, March 8, 2010 will be accepted for the two summer sessions: July 10-18 and July 24-August 1.

The Girls' Leadership Workshop at the Eleanor Roosevelt Center at Val-Kill is open to young women from all over the world who are entering their sophomore or junior year in high school. Applicants are selected on their maturity and leadership potential, social awareness, active volunteer service and academic and extracurricular achievements.
